VOLUNTEER PARKING

All days at Whitewater Spectator Parking lot. Entrance is off the private Whitewater Road (extension of Broadway Avenue), near the intersection of King George's Park Drive. Shuttle buses will take you to the course.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES TENT

VOLUNTEER UNIFORMS

Volunteers are required to wear your Staal Open golf shirt on days scheduled to volunteer. Dress code: prefer black for volunteer's own pants, shorts, skirts/skorts or capris. No denim, sweats, jogging or sloppy cargo pants. No stirrup pants, tights, nor short-shorts allowed. On-course volunteers should wear smooth rubber sole shoes.

WHAT ELSE TO BRING?

Check the weather; pack and dress appropriately (rain gear, umbrella). Bring a folding chair if assigned to a stationary location. There are no lockers or storage areas at the event— please keep track of your own belongings.

IMPORTANT! Together with your volunteer shirt, your volunteer badge credential is your entry to the event on days scheduled to volunteer. It also entitles you to free parking and is your admission ticket for the Volunteer Appreciation Party on Sunday, July 15th.

Please use the refuse containers and if you see litter on the ground, please pick it up and dispose of it in a refuse container. Let's keep the grounds looking good.

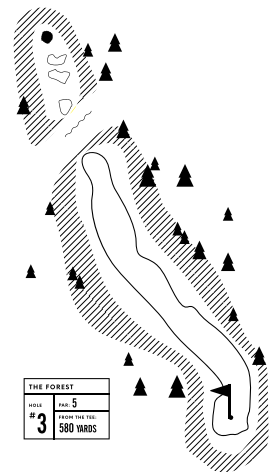
VOLUNTEER CONDUCT

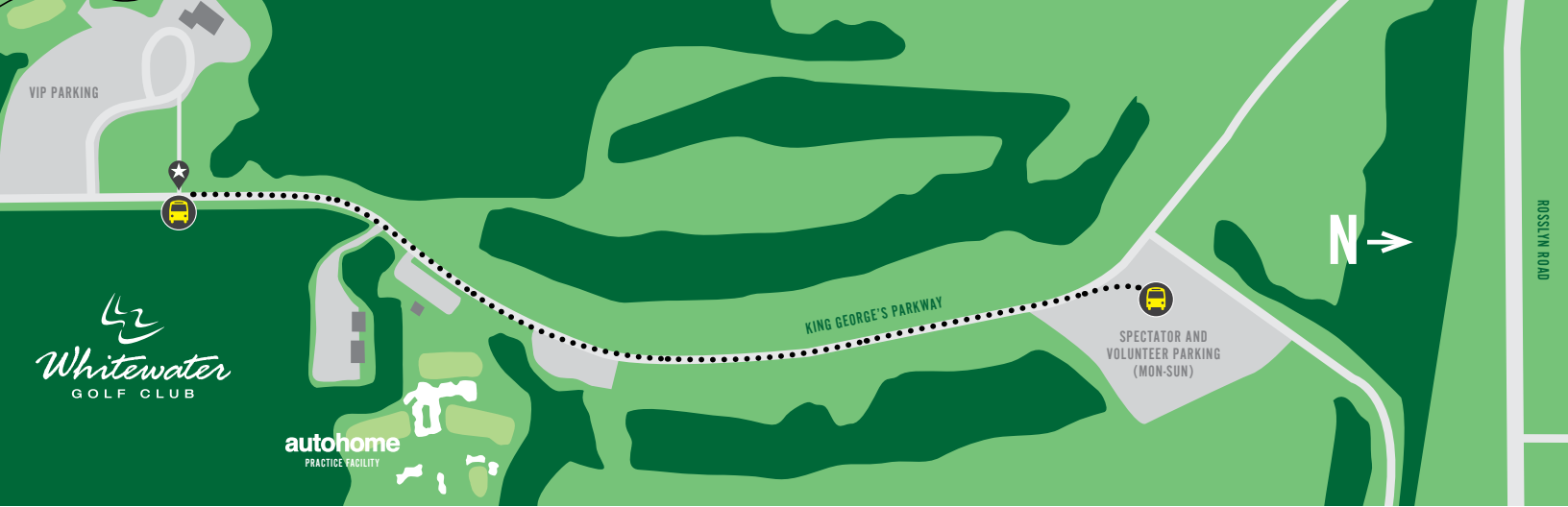
